LA County Water District 40 wants to change allocation from 220,000 acre feet of water to 100,000 acre feet. This includes the entire valley. Mrs. Avadian indicated the PWD newsletter has shown a very significant drop in use of water by the Palmdale residents. Mrs. Dickey indicated that residents should send letters to Mr. Antonovich letting him know how you feel. An acre foot is 325,000 gallons.
